



Beaver Street Temporary Roadway Re-opening

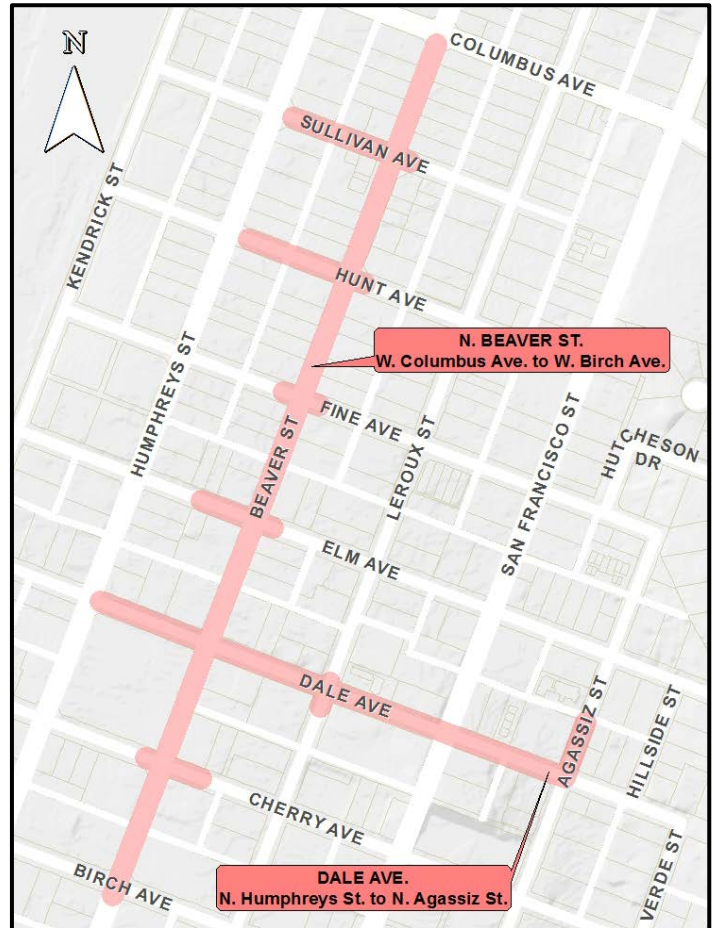

Update on the Road Repair and Street Safety Program Bundle #2 Beaver/Dale Project, a 15-block utility and roadway improvements project located on:

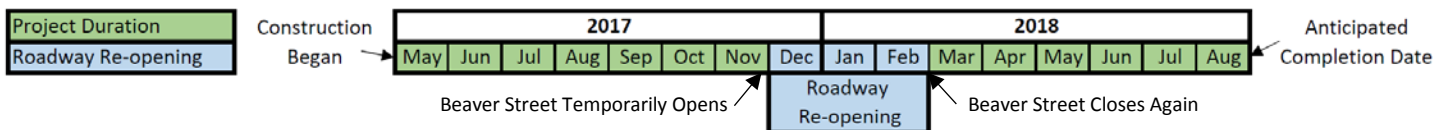
- **Beaver Street** from *Columbus Avenue* to *Birch Avenue*
- **Dale Avenue** from *Humphreys Street* to *Agassiz Street*



- **BEAVER STREET WILL OPEN TO TRAFFIC DECEMBER 22 THROUGH FEBRUARY 19**
- Two lanes will open for southbound traffic
- Occasional single lane closures may occur from Tuesday through Thursday
- Connecting side streets will be open for traffic flow across Beaver Street, except for Dale Avenue
- The final roadway and pavement improvements on Beaver Street south of Elm Avenue will begin at the end of the temporary roadway re-opening
- NAIPTA bus route #2 will continue operating temporarily on Humphreys Street
- **THE DECEMBER 9TH HOLIDAY PARADE OF LIGHTS WILL NOT BE IMPACTED**, pedestrian and parade traffic will be accommodated
- **WINTER CONSTRUCTION WILL OCCUR PRIMARILY ON DALE AVENUE, WHICH WILL REMAIN CLOSED**



The City's general contractor, Eagle Mountain Construction has achieved significant construction benchmarks in delivery of the project. Eagle Mountain Construction has installed, to date, four blocks of roadway improvements and ten blocks of utility improvements, all while encountering and excavating a massive amount rock. (over 80 dump truck loads excavated)
